## Brush Pick-up Services Codified Ordinances § 953

Brush which originates within the Village will be picked up during the period of April through October each year. The Village will conduct scheduled curbside pickups on a rotating basis, and pickups as needed following storms. The specific schedule each year will be determined by the Village Administrator in consultation with the Village Streets and Grounds Coordinator and published in a local paper and/or on the village web page. Brush should not be placed in the Village right of way more than 5 days prior to a scheduled pick-up.

The following requirements must be met or your brush may be rejected for pick-up:

- Not larger than three inches in diameter and not longer than six feet in length.
- Piled with all cut ends pointed toward the street.
- All thorny materials and branches must be bundled separately into bundles no larger than one foot in diameter and tied securely with cotton or equivalent string. Brush placed in bags and other containers will not be picked up.
- All dirt and debris must be removed from the upper plant structure and roots.
- The brush to be picked up originates within the boundaries of the Village.
- The brush to be picked up shall not in and of itself, or by nature of its packaging present a clear and present threat to the safety and welfare of any persons handling the brush and shall not constitute a threat to damage the equipment involved in the removal and transportation of the brush.
- Brush shall be placed on the Village right-of-way so that it does not impede traffic, present a hazard to pedestrians, blocks drains, alters the flow of storm water, blocks sidewalks, ditches, etc or in any other way or manner, endanger the general public.
- Brush generated as a result of hired tree service work is not eligible for chipping and will neither be chipped as part of our route nor is it eligible for drop off at the village's bunker.
- Brush rejected for pick-up must be removed from the right-of-way within three days.

The Village of Fayette will also accept brush in the bunker at the old barn off of Eagle Street (near the water tower). The above rules also apply to brush dropped there, and non-approved materials may not be deposited there.
